Historical Background

Edwin Guy "E. G." McGriff (1868-1938) was an early Las Vegas resident and farmer. With the purchase of land and water rights adjacent to the Yonema "Bill" Tomiyasu family farm, the 40-acre McGriff Ranch was developed as a fruit producing farm. McGriff married Olive Higgins (1872-1962) in 1893, and had one daughter, Della. In addition to being a farmer on his ranch, McGriff served as Chairman of the Clark County Commission and was an entrepreneur. His daughter, Della, married Francis DeVinney in approximately 1920. DeVinney worked as the Clark

County Tax Accessor from 1926 to 1946, and the couple lived at 516 Bridger Avenue in Las Vegas where they raised their daughter, Florence.
