Biographical Note

Jeff Gale was a photographer, conservationist, and animal advocate based in Las Vegas, Nevada. In the 1980s, he owned and operated Photo Finish which at one time was the largest studio and first digital lab in the state of Nevada. His photographs were often featured on advertising billboards arounds Las Vegas. Gale also was a member of the board of directors for Conservation International, an environmental organization. With Conservation International,

Gale photographed bio-diversity and landscapes around the world. He was also a longtime leader of the Animal Foundation, one of the highest-volume single-site animal shelters in the U.S.

Gale married Janie Greenspun in 1988 and they eventually became owners of Gilcrease Farms near the Centennial Hills neighborhood in northwest Las Vegas where they raise chickens and grow produce. Gale passed away on September 19, 2022.
