Historical Note

The College of Human Performance and Development was established at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) in 1981 and was organized into three departments: Health Education and Sports Injury Management, Kinesiology, and Sports and Leisure Studies. The college offered both

undergraduate and graduate course offerings to prepare students for careers in disciplines such as sports medicine, physical therapy, health education, and recreation industries. The college was dissolved in approximately 1998 and the three departments were reorganized under different schools at UNLV.
