Car Check

A "Free Car Check" is being offered to motorists by the California State Automobile Association — Nevada Division, as part of its "Free Car Care Program" which will be at Meadows Mall Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, Oct. 6, 7, and 8.

The program is designed to help motorists drive safer, more efficient vehicles. It is being run by the CSAA in cooperation with the Governor's Office of Community Services.

The "Free Car Check" will be an actual check of a vehicle's fluid levels, tire pressure, lights and other safety-related items. In addition, a free fuel economy test will be provided.

The check takes about six minutes per car. It is performed by CSAA staff technicians on a first-come, first-served basis.

The program operates

from a bright yellow van that has a banner above it proclaiming, "Free Car Check."

The van will be located in the outer parking area of the red parking lot at the JC Penney end of the mall.

The hours of operation are from 10am to 5pm on Tuesday and Wednesday and from 10am to 3pm on Thursday, barring actual precipitation.

Lockers

Locker Assignment

New areas will be assigned for large and small student lockers for the fall semester when a student presents an ID card with fall sticker or paid registration receipt. Those wishing refunds must return their locks and beige lock receipt to be validated at the equipment room. For new students, all lockers must be assign-

ed and no personal locks are permitted. Valid ID or registration receipt must be presented, along with the following fees, to either of the equipment rooms.

Small lockers (10" x 10") have a \$5 refundable lock deposit, and no locker fee. Large lockers (10" x 36") - \$5 refundable lock deposit and \$10 semester fee.

Equipment Checkout Rules

UNLV student discount towel cards are available at the locker rooms. Checkout rules for fall semester require validated ID for equipment and towel rental. No keys, bags, billfolds, driver's license will be accepted. Checkout equipment is numbered and the same number that is checked out must be returned to secure ID.

The complex is open from 6am to 10pm, Mon-

day through Friday; 8am to 8pm Saturday and 10am to 6pm on Sunday.
