

## Davis-Cosby at Hilton

Veteran entertainers, Sammy Davis, Jr and Bill Cosby open at the Las Vegas Hilton Oct. 13 for a six-day engagement.

With a career that spans almost six decades and includes achievements such as Royal Command Performances in London, Las Vegas club dates, big screen and television hits and Broadway fame, Sammy Davis, Jr has overcome racial barriers, a near-fatal car accident and a bout with liver disease.

Davis' list of achievements is remarkable by any standards. He has recorded over 40 albums and his singles have sold millions of copies. From his early hits of Hey There from the

Broadway show *Pajama Game* and *This Is My Beloved*, Davis has long topped the record charts and continues to claim the



gold with songs that include *Don't Blame The Children*, *Shelter of Your Arms*, *Gonna Build A Mountain*, *Black Magic*, *I Gotta Be Me*, *What King of Fool Am I?* and *Candy Man*.

Sharing the stage with Davis is one of today's

hottest stars. Bill Cosby is, by any standards, one of the most influential stars in America today. Whether it be through concert appearances or recording, television or films, commercials or education, Cosby has the ability to touch people's lives like no other entertainer can.

The master storyteller's television show has occupied the No.1 position on the *New York Times* best seller list for

over 25 weeks and his status as No.1 yearly TVQ polls only confirms his appeal.

## Hemsley on Jazz Dance

Talented dancer and choreographer Winston DeWitt Hemsley will share his insights on the art of jazz dance in the next presentation of the Southwest Gas Distinguished Artists Series, Oct. 13 and 15 on the UNLV campus.

Hemsley will present two advanced jazz master classes, which are free and open to the public. Both classes start at 2 p.m. in the Alta Ham Fine Arts Building, Room 110.

He will also be featured in the University Dance Theatre Concert Oct. 31 and Nov. 1, which is a dance tribute to Billie Holiday. The concert, which

will showcase a suite of black spirituals Hemsley choreographed for UNLV, will begin at 2pm in the Judy Bayley Theatre.

An accomplished dancer, choreographer and musician, Hemsley has appeared in numerous Broadway musicals, including *Golden Boy*, *A Chorus Line*, *Hello Dolly*, and *Eubie!*, a musical tribute to jazz great Eubie Blake. As a choreographer, he is credited with several shows, including the MGM Grand's *Jubilee*, *Hello, Hollywood, Hello*, and the famous *Lido de Paris* in Paris. He also choreographed the televi-

sion special, *NBC Christmas in Washington*.

A graduate of New York's High School of the Performing Arts, Hemsley is a long-time Las Vegas resident. He teaches dance regularly in Southern Nevada and is actively involved in UNLV's dance program and the Simba Talent Development Center, a non-profit organization that brings dance to the community.
