## kynyrd returns to build new Legend

One of the best-loved rock bands to emerge Lynyrd Skynyrd's career was tragicaly cut short a decade ago. With the deaths of singer Ronnie Van Zant and guitarist Steve Gaines in a 1977 light plane crash, the group was silenced at its peak. Their stirring R&B and country-flavored rock remains popular ten years later.

The time is more than ripe for a celebration of this classic American rock unit. Legend, newlyreleased by MCA, gathers together little-heard and previously-unreleased tracks by the band under the supervision of surviving members and producer Tom Dowd. The LP reaffirms Lynyrd Skynyrd's status as a band of passion, technical excellence and musical
