Philosophy professor Michael Scriven will present the next University Forum Series lecture Dec. 9, 7:30 pm, in UNLV's John S. Wright Hall, Room 116. The lecture, titled *Reintroducing Values in the Academy*, is free and open to the public.

A professor at the University of Western Australia, Scriven earned a doctorate in philosophy from Oxford University. He has taught at several American colleges, including the universities of Minnesota, Indiana, and California-Berkeley.

Author of several books on philosophy and reasoning, Scriven's *Reasoning* has become one of the most influential publications on modern logic of natural reasoning.

While visiting UNLV, Scriven will address

several university philosophy classes as a visiting scholar-in-residence. His topics will include argument analysis in current policy problems and logical theory and business ethics.
