

# UNLV basketball ticket policy explained

For the purpose of this policy, UNLV students will be classified into the following three categories:

1. full-time, currently enrolled students (individual distribution)
2. full-time, currently enrolled students who

belong to a CSUN recognized student organization (group distribution)

3. part-time, currently enrolled students (part-time student distribution).

**DISTRIBUTION TO INDIVIDUAL STUDENT**

Full-Time, currently enrolled students will be able to pick up a single ticket from the Thomas and Mack Center ticket windows marked "Individual Students" provided the following conditions are met:

1. a current, validated student ID card is presented. Validation stickers may be picked up in the Moyer Student Union by those students who present a tuition fee receipt indicating at least full time enrollment.
2. tickets for individual students will be distributed on a "first come-first served" basis for sections 109, 110, 212, 213, 214 and 215 of the Thomas and Mack Center, on the dates listed below.
3. individual students may secure a second ticket for games provided they present the student ID card of a currently enrolled, full time student. This provision is included to accommodate students attending classes during the ticket distribution hours.
4. individual, full-time enrolled students will not be able to purchase additional tickets in the student section.
5. any person using a student ticket to gain admission to the Thomas and Mack Center for a basketball game will be required to present a full-time, validated, current student ID card.

from the Thomas and Mack athletic ticket office window marked "Groups" provided the following conditions are met:

1. the organization is responsible for securing a certificate of recognition from the CSUN office prior to the distribution of tickets.
2. a representative of the organization will present the certificate and the validated, full-time student ID cards of interested members to the ticket office where the cards will be checked and the tickets distributed.
3. group seating will be distributed on a "first come, first served" basis for sections 101, 123, 112, and 216. Distribution beyond that will be to GA sections.
4. organizations with over 40 members will receive lower level seating for 40 only and upper level seating for the remainder. Each organization will establish the manner in which tickets will be distributed to members. The organization will also be responsible for returning ID cards to members.
5. organization members will not be able to purchase additional tickets in the student section at discounted or full prices as was possible in the past.
6. any person using student tickets to gain admission to the Thomas and

Mack Center for a basketball game will be required to produce a validated full-time student ID card.

**DISTRIBUTION TO PART-TIME STUDENTS**

Part-time students may receive tickets following these procedures:

1. present a current student ID card indicating part-time student status to the athletic ticket window, Thomas and Mack Center.
2. a part-time student will be issued one ticket per game at a price of one-half the face value of the ticket.

**NOTES**

A. For undergraduate students, full-time enrollment is 12 or more credit hours; for graduate students, full-time enrollment is 6 or more credit hours. Part-time is anything less than full-time.

B. Every student who presents a properly validated ID card will be issued a ticket until the supply of tickets is exhausted, but tickets for students will not be held beyond the close of the Athletic Ticket windows on the day before game day. Both individual and group seating will be available under the procedures listed above.

Eligible students who return to the campus after the December 28th ticket distribution date will be able to secure individual tickets for any remaining games in this distribution by presenting their validated student ID card at the Athletic Ticket Windows.
