Suthern II, who was born in 1946, became the first black organist to perform on the CBS network. While a student at Western Reserve University, he gave a recital before the American Guild of Organists at Youngstown, Ohio. No black organist had ever been invited to do so before.

17. Huey Newton, leader and founder of the Black Panther Party was born in Monroe, Louisiana in 1942.

18. Quakers of Germantown, Pennsylvania made first formal protest against slavery in colonial America in 1688.
