worried by the closure.

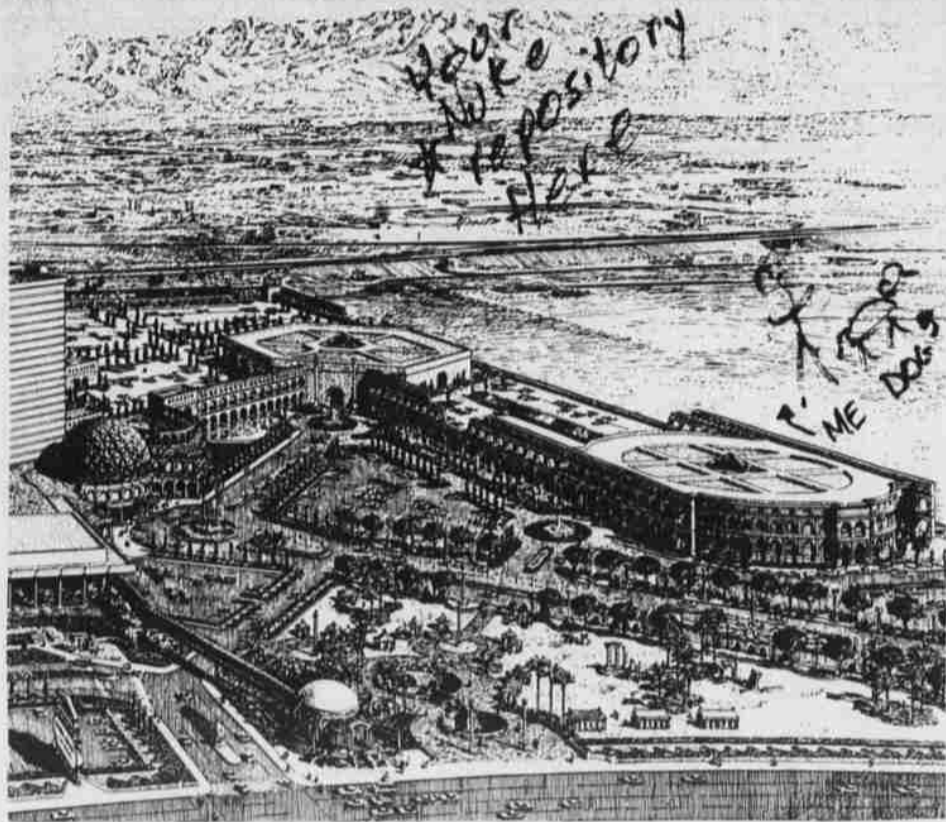
"I am not worried by the closure," he said.
