#### Registration

Registration for Fall Semester classes at UNLV is set for Aug. 24-25 in the Thomas and Mack Center. Fall classes begin Aug. 26 and run through Dec. 9.

UNLV officials are expecting another recordbreaking enrollment this fall. They predict a total headcount of more than 14,000 students.

of Distribution registratio forms to admitted students will be made at specific times, according to each student's year through (freshman graduate) and alphabetically by last name. The schedule appears on page 8 of the Fall Semester 1988 Schedule of Classes, available in the Registrar's Office, Maude Frazier Hall.

Distribution to special students--those not formally admitted--is set for noon-7pm Aug. 25 in the Thomas and Mack Center.

Students who cannot register during their scheduled time may do so during late registration, Registrar's Office.

Registration fees are \$40 per credit hour for undergraduate classes, \$50 per credit hour for graduate classes.

#### Scholarship

Two new scholarships will be available for women students for the 1988-89 academic year. The Governor's Conference for Women Scholarship is a four-year

award presented to freshman students who can receive up to \$1,250 per year. The Women of Achievement Scholarship is a one-year, \$1,000 scholarship available to Aug. 29-Sept. 2, at the juniors and seniors. Both programs have been established to support mature women who, as heads of households, plan to further their education to upgrade employment skills needed to enter or return to the job market. Part-time students are eligible to apply for either scholarship. The application deadline is Aug. 5 and interested students can contact Del Rae in Student Financial Services, 739-3424 for applications or more information.

#### Survey

sociology UNLV's department surveyed Southern Nevadans on their perceptions regarding the May 4 Henderson industrial explosion at the PEPCON Plant.

The telephone survey was conducted during the last two weeks of June from the facilities at the university's Center for Survey Research. UNLV sociology professor James Frey directed the study.

Frey said 750 area residents, selected through a random selection pro-

cedure, were contacted. Henderson residents were oversampled in the study.

Residents were asked about a wide range of subjects regarding the explosion, including what they did immediately following the blast, how they rate emergency services provided, what injuries or property damage they sustained, and how they feel about media coverage of the disaster.

Frey said this study will fill a gap in the overall picture of the disaster. Officials have focused on a variety of information regarding the blast, but, until now, no one has assessed what the people think about it, Frey said. The results of the study will be available around the end of summer.


