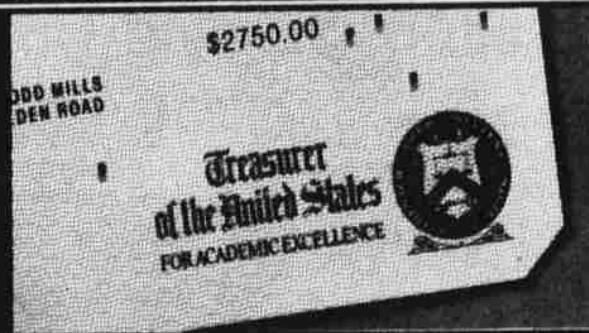
The sculpture, depicting three intertwined hands, was created by Las Vegas artist John Juliano and reflects the relationship between the
