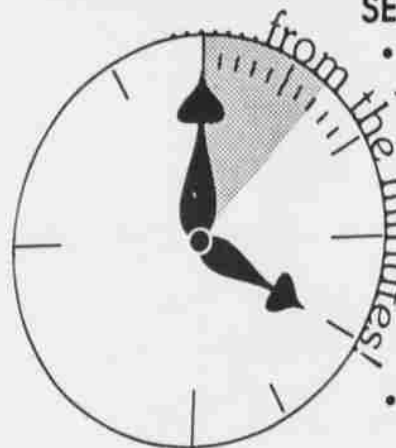

- The Senate approved \$2400 for election equipment.
