

# Law Day coming to UNLV

The Career Planning and Admission Test. Placement Office and Division of Continuing Education are coordinating the university's fifth annual Law Day Forum set for Monday, Nov. 13 in Artemus Ham Concert Hall on campus from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Anyone considering a legal career will want to attend this one-stop information session on financial aid, admission procedures and preparation for the Law School Admission Test. The forum can be important for Nevadans, because the state has no American Bar Association-approved school and the information would otherwise have to be obtained through time consuming correspondence or costly travel, said Larry Strate, business law professor and faculty advisor to the UNLV pre-law society, Phi Alpha Delta.

Strate added that Law Day is also beneficial for those students planning their undergraduate course. "We pass along much of the feedback from our former students currently in law schools," he said. "Students who plan their classes armed with this information can increase their chances of success in law school," he said.

# Player wins award

Larry Johnson, a junior, has been voted Athlete of the Year by the Amateur Basketball Association of America.

This award is given out every year by the ABA-USA to the amateur player that best represents the United States in international competition during the summer.

Johnson, along with teammate Stacey Augmon, starred on the World University Games Team, which won a gold medal this summer in West Germany. He led the team with a 16-point and 12 rebounds per game, averaged against teams from around the world.

Johnson is the first UNLV player and junior college player to ever receive this award. He transferred to the university this year, after spending two years at Odessa Junior College in Texas. He will start playing his first year at UNLV this season.
