

tor, after whom the building was named, donated \$500,000 and J.A. Tiberti, a Las Vegas builder, donated \$400,000.

The magnitude of the building has grown from 8,000 square feet to 23,000 square feet and went from \$800,000 to its current price.

This two-story, two-wing building was designed by Gerald Garapich and Associates.

Albrecht said the new alumni center will allow the University's Alumni Relations office to expand its programming, host social functions like class reunions, honor scholarship luncheons and dinners, and start a student alumni center.

It will also house the Alumni Association offices, campus visitation center, a faculty sclub and a small art gallery.


Albrecht said in the past alumni relations had seminars in which alumni could come back and speak on various topics for students.

But now that the university is growing there are no rooms to rent out, he said.

The Alumni center will allow them to invite alumni to come back and get directly involved with students about various career opportunities, said Albrecht. "By having our own facility we can control our own destiny."
