PMS/cramps kits have been developed by the Student Health Center to encourage students to be responsible for their own health needs. They can be picked up and the Student Health Center.

Contents include non-prescription medication and information about how and when to decide if professional medical care is needed.

Self-care kits have been developed by the UNLV Student Health Center to promote education of the student consumer in self-care concepts. The self-care concept is defined as providing access to health aids, health information, and instructional materials that assist students in making their own health care decisions. The kits encourage students to be responsible for their own health H needs and provide realistic information about how and when to make h decisions about whether or not professional care is needed.

All students owing fees to the Student Health Center should pay before finals. Any unpaid fees will result in a Stop Enrollment. This means grades may be withheld, you will not be able to register for classes, and other services will be stopped until this debt is cleared.


