The forum features Southern Nevada community members, the media and dignitaries who will participate in the discussions. Mod-

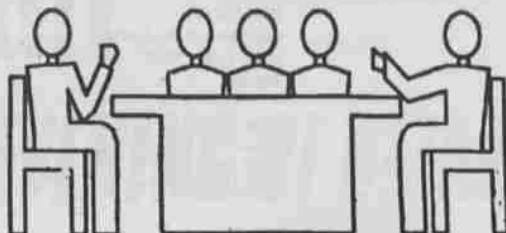

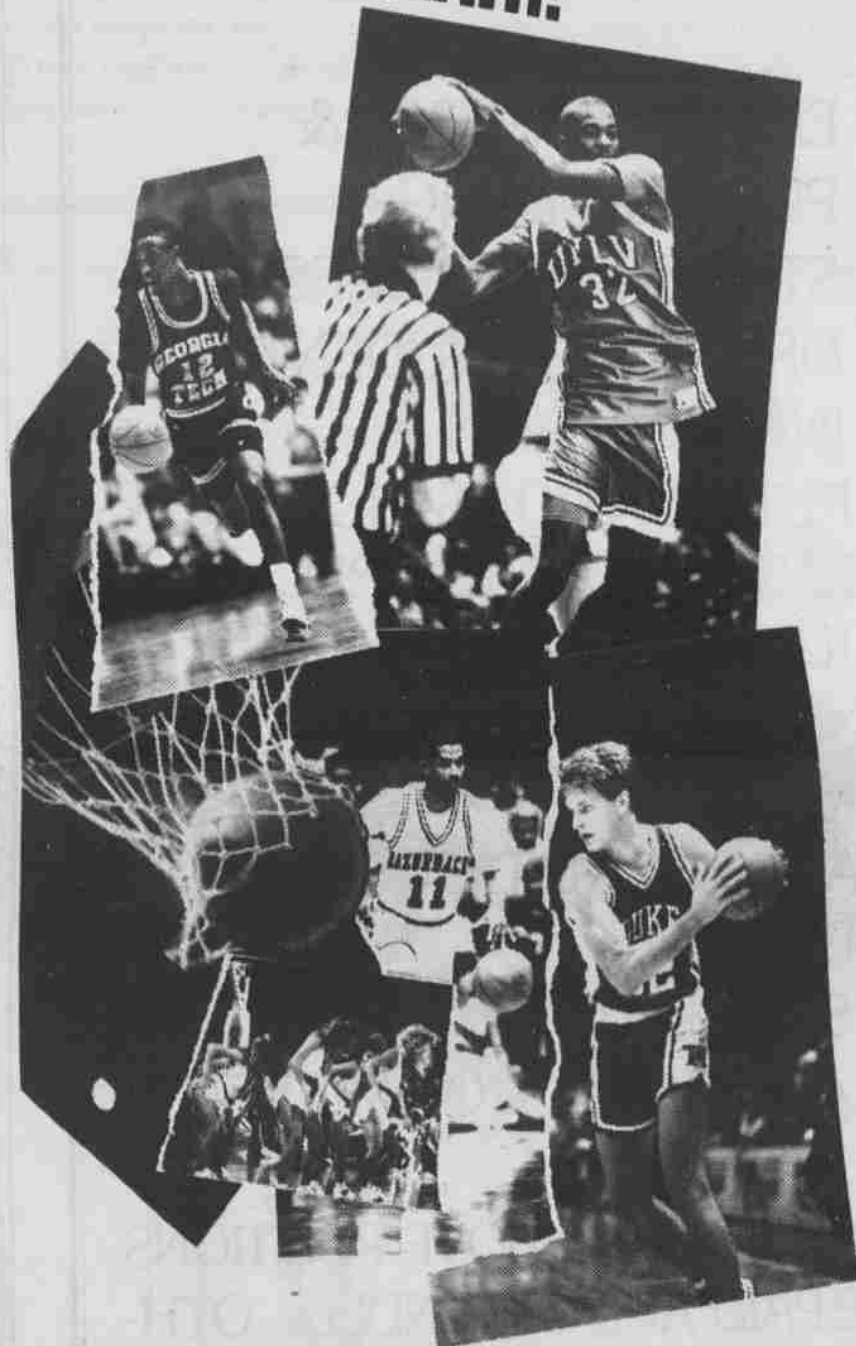
