Championship highlights on video sports

One of America's premiere sporting events will come to home video April 20 with CBS/FOX Video Sports' "The Official 1990 NCAA Championship Video". Rush released just 18 days after the final game, this video captures all the action and drama of the NCAA basketball tournament leading up to and including the Final Four games and championship.

Produced by CBS Sports and Black Canyon Productions, the program contains footage exclusive to home video. Narrated by CBS Sports announcer Jim Nantz, "The

Official 1990 NCAA Championship Video" features highlights of the final four teams: Georgia Tech, Arkansas, UNLV, and Duke. In addition to spotlighting other great basketball stars and events during the tournament this program also includes:

- A recap of all the special moments of this year's tournaments, all the stunning upsets and the emotional charge of Loyola-Marymount.

- All the incredible buzzer-beaters of the tournament including Connecticut's Tate George's last

second prayer.

- Christian Laettner's last second jump shot to send Duke to the Final Four.

- Special behind-the-scenes coverage in Denver.

John Gaffney, Director of Sports and Music Marketing said, "These championships have been America's premiere sporting event for the past 10 years. We are thrilled to be associated with the NCAA."

"The Official 1990 NCAA Championship Video" will be sponsored by Rawlings, the official manufacturer of the basketball used

in the Final Four tournament. They will receive a package credit and two 30-second commercials on the video, one before the program and one after.

CBS/FOX plans a two-tier marketing campaign for "The Official 1990 NCAA Championship Video". One a national level, CBS/FOX will run a radio give-away promotion in the final 16 markets. Advertisements for the video will run in the daily sports newspaper, The National. On a regional level, CBS/FOX will run television advertisements on Las Vegas stations

and print advertisements in the student newspapers at Duke University and UNLV.

"The Official 1990 NCAA Championship Video" is CBS/FOX Video Sports' first NCAA basketball release. It will be available in video stores on April 20, 1990 for a suggested retail price of \$19.98. The video has a running time of 60 minutes, a dealer order cut off date of April 12, 1990 and catalogue number 2541. Recorded in Hi-Fi, it is available in VHS and Beta formats.

UNLV basketball recruits new players

UNLV Runnin' Rebel basketball added two members to their squad as two players have signed national letters of intent to come here.

Dexter Boney, a guard from Hagerstown Junior College in Maryland and Elmore Spencer out of Connors State College in Oklahoma, signed their letters last week.

Boney signed his letter last Tuesday when the Rebels were in Washington D.C. meeting President Bush. Boney averaged 31.6 points a game, 56 percent including 37 percent from three point range for Hagerstown this season. He was also named the most valuable player at the National Junior College All-Star Game in Midland, Texas.

Spencer had verbally committed

to UNLV prior to his signing on Friday. However, Spencer's letter is not binding in the event he does not complete his Associates Arts Degree from Connors.

Spencer is a 270 pound, seven foot center with the ability to pass the ball. Spencer will have to share playing time with George Ackles who was redshirted this season due to a broken wrist.

With the signing of Spencer and Boney, UNLV now has four players committed by letters of intent. The other two players are Shon Tarver of Santa Clara High School in Oxnard, California and Dedan Thomas of Antelope Valley College in Lancaster, California whom the Rebels placed after he didn't qualify for admission last fall.

Tarver's letter is not binding in the event that UNLV is put on probation by the NCAA.



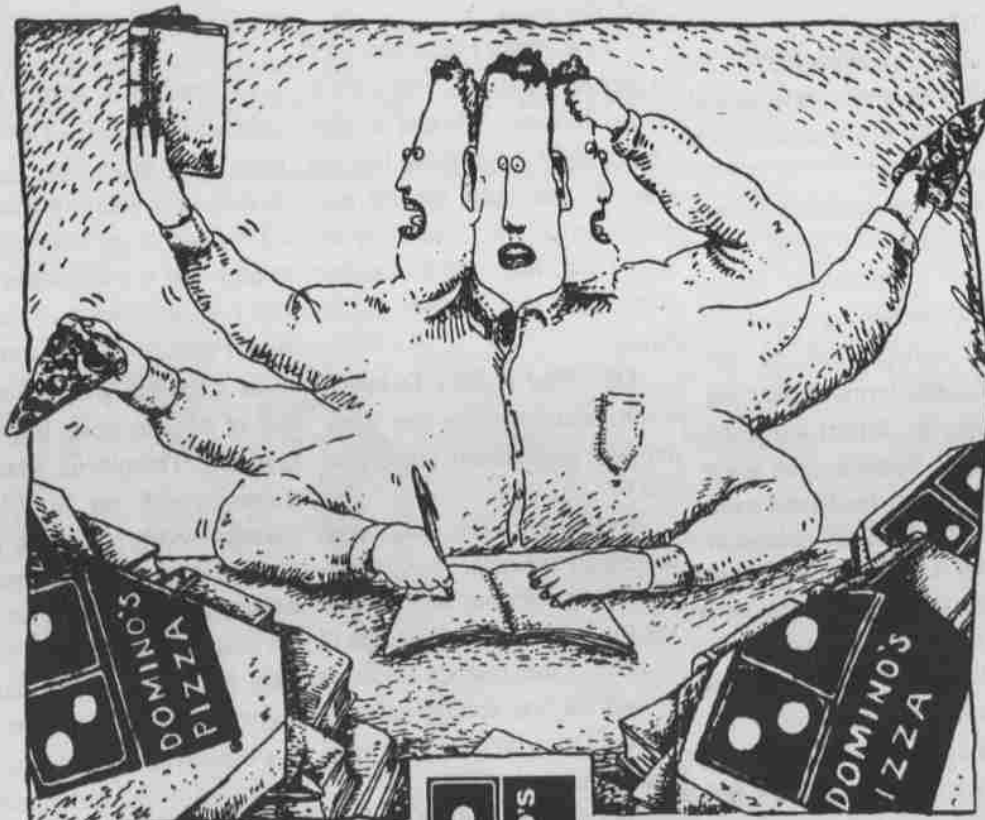

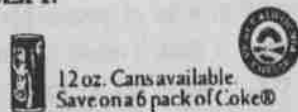
