# Rebel soccer team sweeps weekend matchups

The UNLV Rebel soccer team, anchored by the Big West Player of the Week, freshman goalie Dan Schell, swept a critical homestand this weekend against two Big West Conference opponents, UC Irvine 2-0 and UC Santa Barbara 2-0.

Schell, a true freshman, was named Big West Player of the Week tallying shutouts in both of the victories.

The Rebels, coming off two straight losses, got a much needed victory Friday night against the Anteaters. However, the game was marred by penalties, with a total of 39 fouls recorded.

The first Rebel to tally a goal was junior forward Terry Pryer, who collected a pass from freshman forward Ben Erickson and shot it past the UCI goalie Mike Gartlan. The Rebel's second goal of the contest came at 54:57 when senior forward Doug Borgel scored on a penalty kick.

The defense and Schell hung tough for the rest of the game,

preserving the victory and the shutout. The Rebels improved their record to 6-5-2, 3-2 in the Big West Conference and UC Irvine fell to 4-10-2, 0-4-1.

On a sunny Sunday afternoon, the Rebels faced Big West leader UC Santa Barbara, who was playing without four starters. The players were benched because they broke curfew. The Gauchos' offense struggled, recording only six shots on goal.

The Rebels got on the board with only seconds remaining in the first half. Borgel kicked in a cross from junior defender Mike Madrid. The second Rebel goal was registered by senior defender Cliff Odle. Odle kicked in a score from 25 yards out.

With the victory, the Rebels moved into second place in the Big West, as they improved their record to 7-5-2, 4-2. The loss dropped the Gauchos to third place and a record of 7-5, 3-2.

The Rebels will head to California for this weekend rematches with UC Santa Barbara, Friday, and UC Irvine, Sunday.
