Career Planning and Placement Center needs funding to realize goals

Computerized career planning programs, better marketing and more employers on campus are what Eileen McGarry, new director of the career planning and placement office, intends to accomplish.

The career planning and placement center's goal is to "help in every phase of the career planning process," McGarry said. Information and assistance are provided for students of all majors. The center offers advising and counseling, workshops, seminars, on-campus recruiting, and job vacancy and internship notices.

Also, the center sponsors career day with the Alumni Association. This year, over 60 companies are expected to attend. In January, a career placement manual will be available for the first time. It will include a list of the companies expected on career day and articles concerning the job search.

The career planning and placement office is a division of

Student Services. Funding is supplied by the state legislature and a portion of student tuition. The total budget for this year is \$185,000 with the operating budget at \$4,800. McGarry said donations help, but the center would like to see the budget grow.

"It's up to the director (of student services) to understand the direction the program needs to go and that the budget needs to go with that," she said.

Robert Ackerman, vice-president of Student Services, distributes the funds. He said many departments need more money. But, he said, "We can only appropriate money based on the money we have."

It is the responsibility of the legislature to increase the amount of money made available. Ackerman told the legislature, "The university needs more resources in order to grow." The university is asking for a total of \$65 million for the coming year, which will increase the current budget by \$21 million. This will be decided when the legislature comes into session.
