

# Farrakhan cries, "Stop the killings" during his visit to Las Vegas

Nation of Islam leader Louis Farrakhan addressed a crowd of 3,000 at the Cashman Field Auditorium saying he entered the city of Las Vegas hoping not to find riches in the casinos but in the minds of many "handicapped" black and white citizens.

Farrakhan called those not having the authority and knowledge to make a difference in society the handicapped individuals.

From the moment he reached the stage, he received standing ovations and cheers from a crowd of about 3,000.

"The reason you are afraid of me is because the media makes you believe I'm the devil," Farrakhan said.

"His theme was entitled "Stop the Killings," but his message was to "Wake Up America." He said blacks must learn not to get upset only when a white man kills a black man because "for every Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, we constantly send each other to the hospital."

Farrakhan said he viewed President Bush as a man trying to keep blacks in the graves of poverty. By vetoing the Civil

Rights Bill and having more blacks than whites fighting in Saudi Arabia, he said, how can a black man prosper?

Farrakhan talked of the history of the country and questioned the government's actions.

"How could we have built this nation, cooked our food or dressed our women unless we had done it earlier? The black man was not found uncivilized in the jungle," he screamed.

Farrakhan said the FBI has

killed every black leader who has ever made a difference but he added, "It's too late, because I'm here on time."

Although his speech may have been predicted to be radical and violent, his passages were more biblical. Farrakhan placed God as the supreme ruler of the world and himself as the prophet who must tell the truth about a "society that is mentally dead."

"When you go against God, you're breathing death," he said.
