Award-winning playwright Marlin-Jones. Included in the cast Red Shuttleworth's new play, "The Children's Hair Turned White," opens Nov. 7 in the Grant Hall Little Theatre at UNLV. The play is a contemporary western nuclear fable set in the Jornada del Muerto in New Mexico, better known as the White Sands Missile Range.

The play is about five people who witnessed the detonation of the first atomic bomb in 1945. These five fictional characters are now in their fifties, but they look to be in their twenties, due to having been subjects in a federal life extension experiment.

The work, a lyrical dramatization combining dance, music and slides, is being directed by UNLV's artist-in-residence, Davey
