## The four stages of alcohol development

The Interfraternity Council teams up with the Moyer Student Union and Sigma Chi to sponsor Mike Green and his "Four Stages of Alcohol Development" presentation.

The presentation that Mike Green delivers to college students around the country is based on the idea of drinking responsibly. Mike Green speaks from his heart about alcoholism; as a reformed alcoholic he shares his experiences and relates them

to the college level student. Mike Green calls his program 2 H.A.L.T T.I.P.S. which means Hungry. Away. Tired. Things. Ingredients. the three P's (People. Peer. Pressure). and Substance. Each of the letters in the title outline his oral presentation to the audience.

The program remains serious but his presentation is done in a funny and enlightening way. The presentation does not try to convince people not to drink but to drink responsibly. It emphasizes to the audience the amount of times a college student is presented the opportunity to drink which could end up being half of the days in the year.

The presentation will also be followed with a Mock Cocktail contests among the Fraternities with a cash prize being awarded to the top three Nonalcoholic drinks. The drinks will be given to the people present from booths set up by each Fraternity. There will also be an award for the best booth with an alcohol awareness theme.

This event is open to all UNLV students. This provides each Fraternity on campus an excellent chance to tell Non-Greeks about their Fraternity and to further their commitment to Alcohol Awareness.
