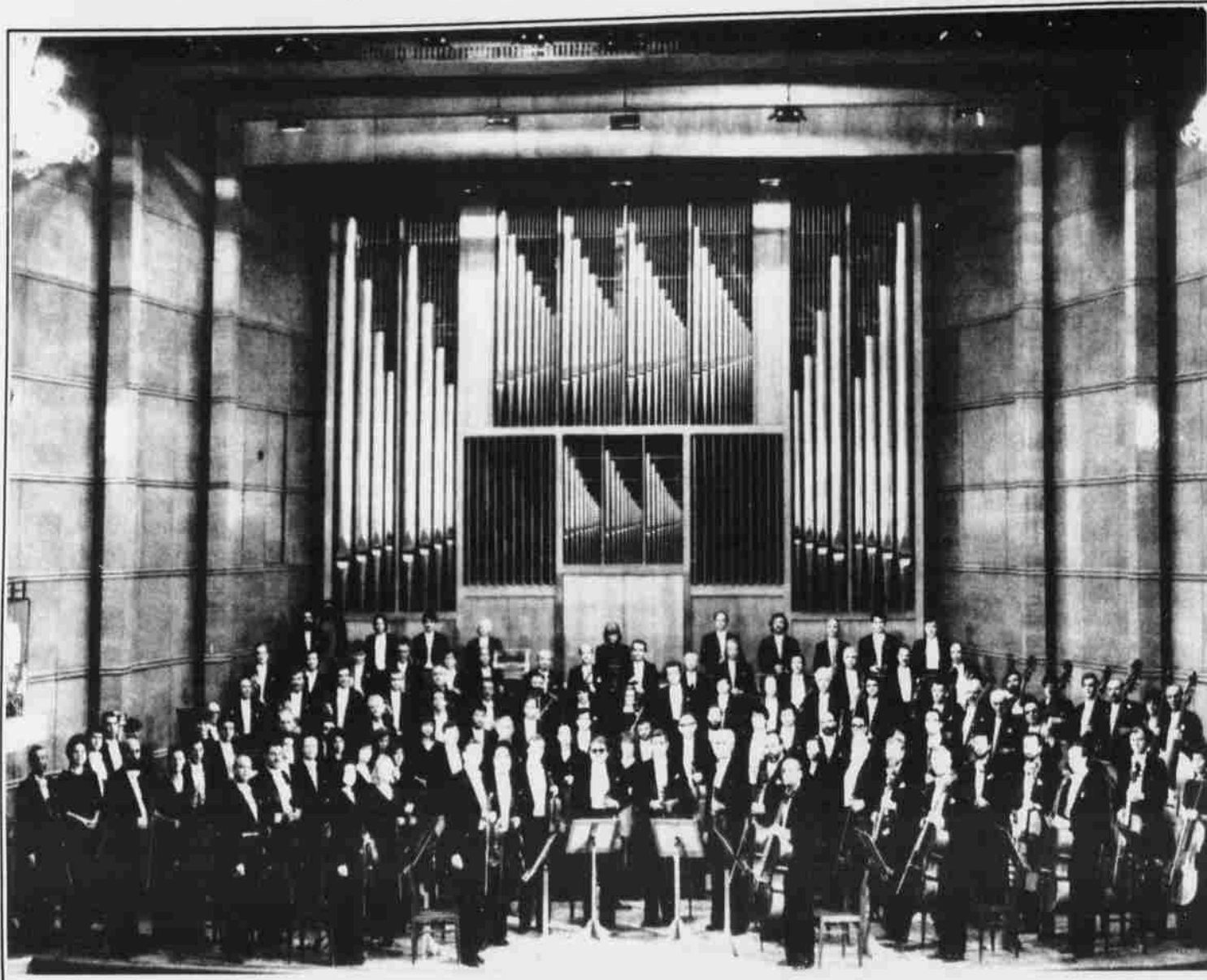


# Sofia Philharmonic performs Nov. 18 at UNLV

## Seed of Darkness premiers

Winner of Sarett Playwriting competition to open at UNLV

The winner of the Sarett Playwriting Competition, Lawrence Riggins, will have his world premier Nov. 14, in the Black Box Theatre at UNLV.

Riggins' play, "Seed of Darkness" covers the last weeks of Edgar Allen Poe's life, wherein he, like his fictional creation August Dupin, tracks a killer. Meanwhile, he's coming to grips with the purpose of his furious art, engendered by a crippling incident of unrequited love that occurred in his youth.

More than a murder mystery, the play is descent into the psychosis of misogyny, the redeeming qualities of art and love, and

the story of a great American poet obsessed with the fairer sex.

The role of Edgar Allan Poe will be played by Shawn Martin, who recently completed the role of Charles Dickens in "Pip's Trip."

Performances will be at 8 p.m., Nov. 14, 15, 16 and 17 with a matinee at 2 p.m. on Nov. 18.
