

The Yellin' Rebel's question to Student Government—"Why?"

But soon, Student Government will meet and vote on another proposal, the essence of which runs completely counter to the liberating of the paper. The proposal would place the paper, and the people who produce it, directly under the scrutiny of Student Government officials.

The proposal essentially says that the computers in the Yellin' Rebel office (yes, the same computers which were stolen a year ago and took nearly that long to re-
