As the day draws near, basketball fans turn to the foremost authority in college basketball myself. Ok, maybe not me, but how about Dick Vitale? Yes, the same Dick Vitale that said on ESPN's Big Monday (Jan. 28) that the Arkansas Razorbacks would hand the Rebels their first loss of the season.

Vitale, who was in town last weekend to cover the Rutgers game for ABC, clarified his statements at Saturday's Rebel basketball practice.

"Arkansas will not be intimidated," Vitale said. "Combine the talent, the environment ... let's face reality - it's a really good
