Vacancies are filled throughout the year. Foreign language knowledge is seldom required. Some overseas schools will hire graduating seniors for student teaching.

America's loneliest road goes glossy

Travelers on U.S. Highway 50 in Nevada — known as the "Loneliest Road in America" — can now receive a free autographed photo of the famed route.

U.S. 50 became known as the loneliest road in America after it was tagged with that label in a 1986 article in *Life Magazine*. The magazine said there were few towns and no points of interest along the 287-mile stretch of U.S. 50 between Ely and Fernley and suggested travelers would need survival skills to make the trip.

Farrel Hansen, director of the White Pine Chamber of Commerce in Ely, Nev., said, "It only seemed appropriate that the road should have its own photo, although I guess pretty soon it's probably going to need an agent."
