The band Maggie's Dream has been out now for about five months, and they are finding it very desirable to be on a major label. Cromer titled "Maggie's American Dream." The band members site such groups as Parliament and a number of 70's rock bands as inspiration but not as a patterning influence on their music. This could only mean that they must put on a great show live, because the album they have out doesn't contain too many over-indulgent qualities.

Unlike most bands, "Maggie" didn't find their way to success in the usual fashion by playing endlessly in local clubs and attracting a huge following. They were spotted by Capitol records first and then signed for the sound and style of their music. It just proves that if one dares to dream and work hard enough, anything is possible.
