Society of Physics Student is sponsoring a T-shirt design contest. In keeping with the mission of SPS to encourage interest in physics, the design should have a physics or technology related

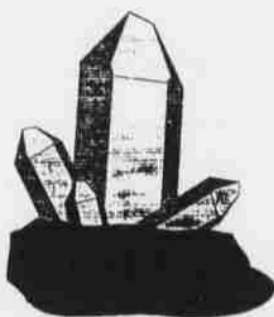
theme. Winner of the contest will be awarded \$25 and a T-shirt with the winning design.
