Undelivered refund checks for 1990

According to IRS Las Vegas District Director Robert E. Withers, the IRS owes money to 509 Nevadans who filed tax returns prior to 1990, but did not receive their refunds.

Withers said these refunds



were issued but returned to the IRS as undeliverable, usually because the taxpayer moved after filing.

Undelivered refunds can be reissued to taxpayers who provide the IRS with a new address. Any taxpayers who believe they have a missing refund for any of the last three years can call (800) 829-1040 to find out if their name is on the list and how to file a claim.
