•"Conservation Biology," June 24-28.

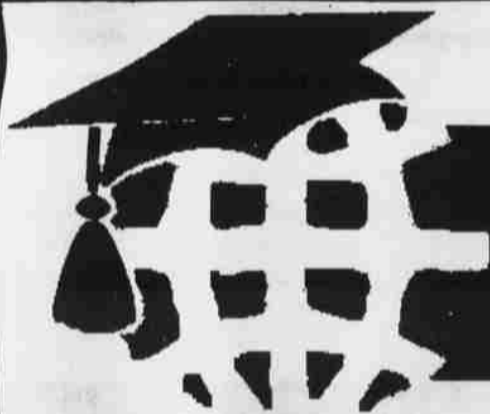
•"Environmental Geology for Teachers," June 24-28.
