

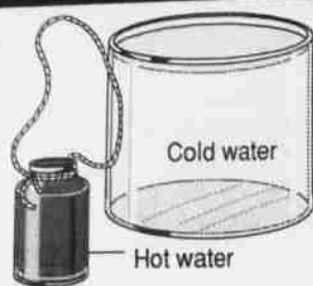
Try this: Volcano

The first experiment demonstrates that heat makes water rise. The second shows how capillary action pulls water upward.

Make an underwater volcano

You'll need: A small bottle; a large glass container full of water; string; food coloring or ink.

- 1 Tie the string around the neck of the bottle.
- 2 Fill the bottle with hot water and add one or two drops of food coloring or ink.



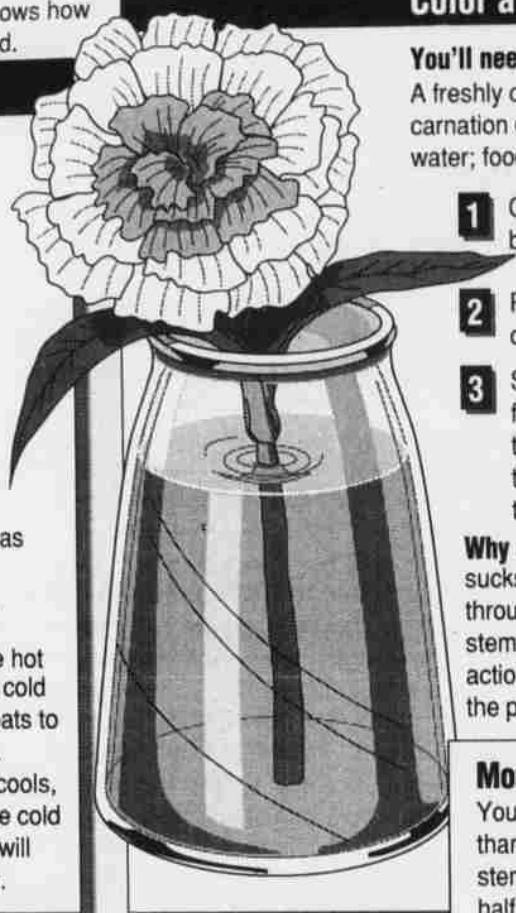
3 Carefully lower the small bottle into the large container. Watch as the colored water rises upward, like a volcano.

Why did it happen? The hot water is lighter than the cold water, so it rises and floats to the top of the container. Later, as the hot water cools, it will mix evenly with the cold water and all the water will become the same color.

Color a flower

You'll need: A freshly cut flower (such as a carnation or daffodil); a vase of water; food coloring or ink.

- 1 Cut about 2 inches off the bottom of a flower stem.
- 2 Put several drops of coloring in a vase of water.
- 3 Stand the flower in the water for several hours. Eventually the petals will begin to turn the color of the water in the vase.



Why did it happen? The flower sucks up the colored water through narrow tubes in its stem. The pull of this capillary action is enough to overcome the pull of gravity.

More things to try

You can make a flower of more than one color by splitting the stem in half and standing each half in different colored water.

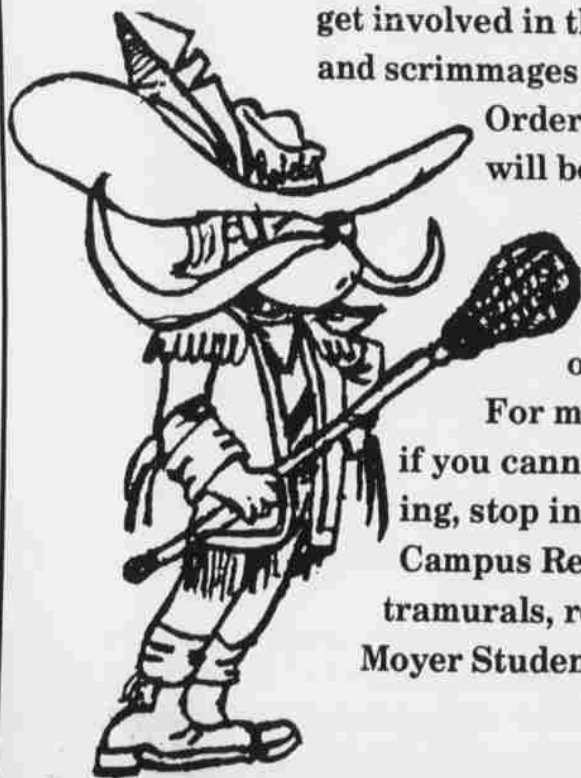
