Judson C. Mitchell has been hired as the university's new personnel director.

Mitchell is from the University of Illinois at Chicago where he has worked for 17 years, serving most recently as assistant chancellor and director of affirmative action. In that job he acted as the primary campus officer for all matters related to affirmative action and equal opportunity.

From 1974 to 1985 he served as that university's

associate director of personnel.

Mitchell also has worked as a recruitment coordinator and counselor for the Chicago Urban League, and as a field specialist for the Opportunities Industrialization Centers of America.

Mitchell earned a master of public administration degree from Governors State University in Illinois and a bachelor of science degree in sociology from Bradley University.

McCallister receives teaching honors

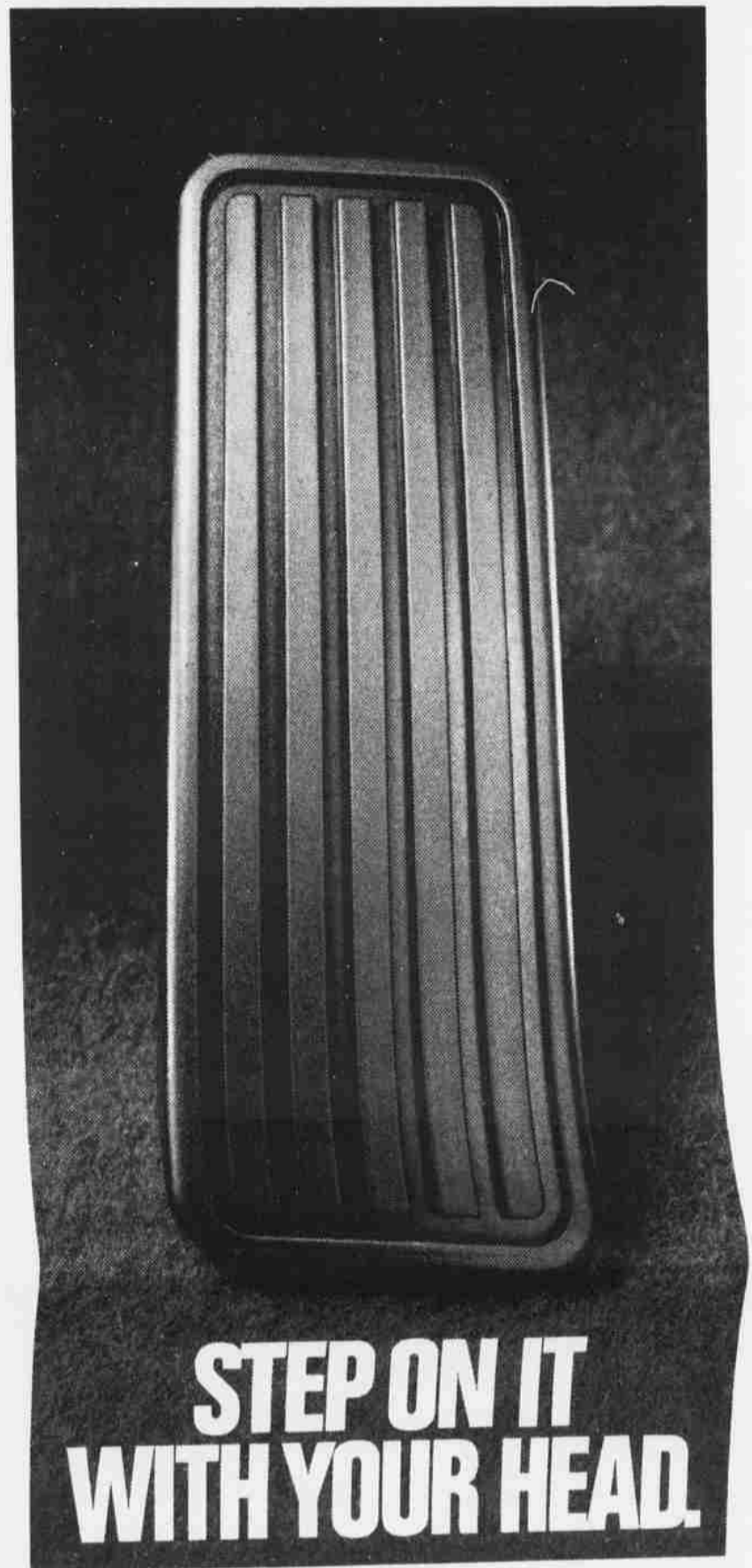
Management professor Daniel McCallister recently received the Distinguished Teaching Award for the College of Business Economics.
