
The university's Distinguished Professor of Management recently received the Distinguished Reseacher Award from the College of Business and Economics.

Kohl received a bachelor's degree from Moravian College and master's degree from Yale University. He earned a second master's degree from American Technical University and a Ph. D from Penn State University.




