by five-year increments. The World Cup is combined into the race and refers to a Grand Prix in which the best triathletes from all over world compete. Points are awarded in 13 races held in places such as Beijing, Ireland, Canada, South America and Australia, where the finals will be held and a \$300,000 grand prize will be awarded. The triathlon started in Hawaii with the birth of the Iron-Man, a grueling contest to determine the best athletes. The original distances combined a 2.4-mile open water swim, a 112-mile bike ride, and a 26.2-mile marathon run—thus the title Iron-Man. The Iron-Man is held yearly in October. However, with the participation of many women, the title may not be entirely accurate. The Las Vegas race will use the most popular distances, known as Olympic or International. Though somewhat shorter, a 1.5-mile swim, 25-mile bike ride and 6.2-mile run will still put any athlete to the test. *Triathlete Magazine* ranked last year's race number one in the world.

**1991 HIV/AIDS Trainings**


