

Easley named tennis coach

Larry Easley, who in three seasons took previously unranked Long Beach State to a No. 2 national collegiate ranking, was named, Friday, to direct the men's tennis program.

Easley, 42, replaces York Struther, who has served as both interim men's and women's coach since the resignation of Craig Witcher in June. Strother will remain interim women's coach through the 1991-92 season.

"Larry is an outstanding coach and is well-respected both nationally and internationally," interim Athletic Director Dennis Finrock said. "We are all

pleased to have an individual with his qualifications as our men's tennis coach. We believe he is the one to lead our program into the national spotlight."

"I've been involved in all different areas of tennis for 26 years, but I really wanted to get back into the collegiate coaching," Easley said. "Every thing here has so much potential. We can produce some good tennis teams."

Easley will take over the men's team that went 18-11 and finished fourth in the Big West Conference Tournament last season.

"My initial goal is to concentrate on building the program; covering all the

bases from administration and recruiting, to scheduling and coaching," said Easley, who was selected from a field of 74 applicants. "I'm a firm believer that if you work hard at what you do, good things will happen. I see no reason why we can't work toward a national championship at UNLV."

Easley's program will benefit from the \$1 million Frank and Vicki Fertitta Tennis Stadium, which is scheduled for completion next summer and will be available for the team to use in the fall of 1992.

"This facility will boost UNLV's tennis reputation immediately," he said.

I just need to relax on the field and not force myself," Garritano said.
