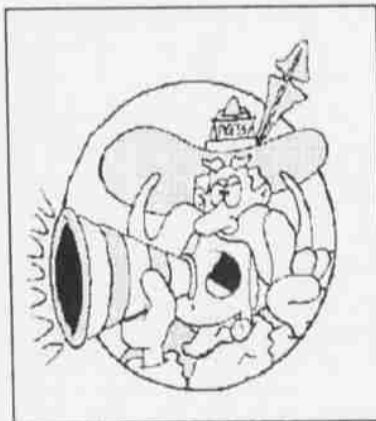
*I wouldn't like it because its an invasion of privacy and student rights. Its an invasion of the faculties rights who's teaching the class.*
