

Overkill and Anacrusis thrash Las Vegas

Speed metal band, Overkill, laid waste to Fuddy Duddy's Saturday night. The New York based group is embarking on an 18 month world tour supporting their fifth album "Horrorscope", the heaviest and most brutal album by them to date. Calling themselves the "New Overkill", D.D. Verni, Bobby "Blitz" Ellsworth and Sid Falck have added two new guitarists to the band.

Playing a 100 minute set, the band was only temporarily slowed by a number of power outages in the p.a. system due to the intense volume of their musical performance. Opening the show with a myriad of strobe lights on stage and the song "Deny the Cross," the band pounded

through a series of older and newer songs despite their set backs. Playing the title tracks off of their first and fifth albums, the band only played one moderately speeded song, "Solitude." Because the bands repertoire is so fast paced, the crowd directly in front of the stage was filled with moshers and people stage diving the entire night.

Being a part of the mid-eighties thrash scene in New York, the "speed metal sweepstakes" which includes Anthrax, Overkill has a very large following. Most of the audience was there to witness the energetic stage show, but was entertained instead by the procession in front of the stage. The major highlights of their set were the songs "Frankenstein" by

the Edgar Winter Group and the two song encore dedicated to the sound crew, "I Hate" mixed with the song "##@! You". Their show was incredible, very high energy and full of emotion and excitement.

Anacrusis, the opening act, was limited to a 30 minute set, but showed off their talents as a thrash band any way. This St. Louis quartet, also making it's Las Vegas debut, got the show moving with four songs off their third and latest album and playing a cover of New Model Army's "I Love the World".

This was definitely the heaviest show to come to Vegas in ages, Fuddy Duddy's should try to acquire more bands of this calibre.

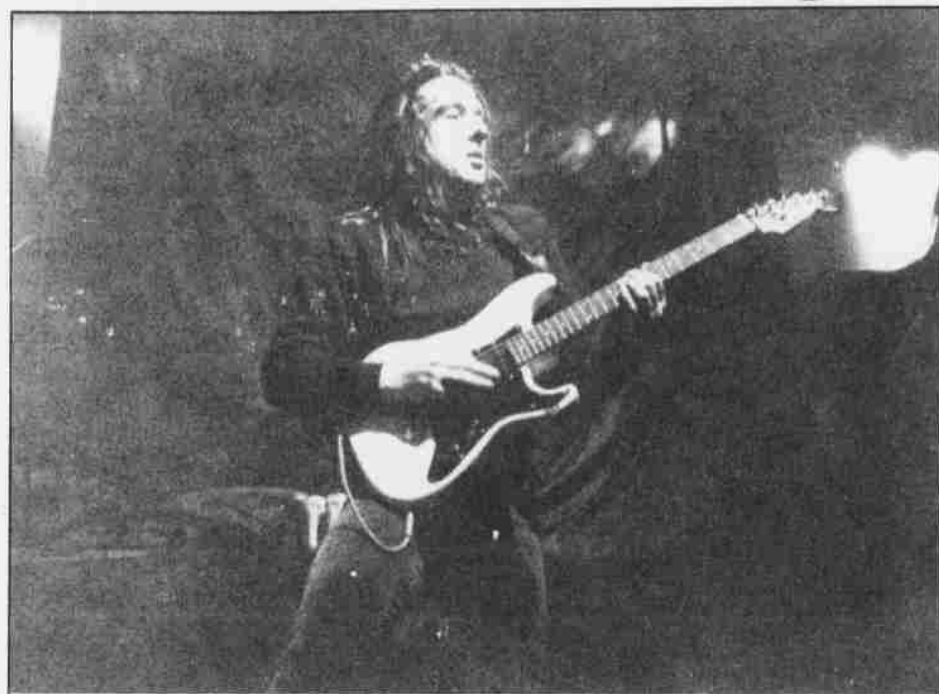

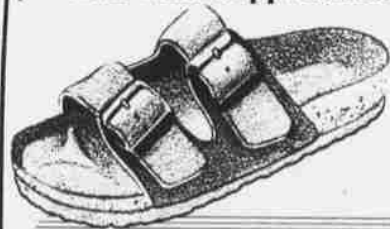
