**Explanation:** 

The Student Health Center currently provides all UNLV students with a variety of limited health care services. However, a national survey comparing UNLV to similar colleges and universities found that UNLV's budget was significantly lower than other similar institutions. This negatively impacts the staffing and services of the UNLV Student Health Center by limiting the number of students seen and the types of services available to all students

Injure yourself on campus? Get sick in class? Have a problem you don't feel you can share with your family doctor? A "yes" vote would allow all UNLV students to continue to use the services at no cost for examination, and allow for expansion of staff and services.

#### 1. Expansion of the Student Health Center will:

- A. Increase Physician's hours from current 20 hours per week to 40 hours per week, and add part time Physician specialists, ie, Allergist, Gynecologist, Dermatologist.
- B. Increase Pharmacist's hours from current 8 hours per week to 40 hours per week, and add a licensed pharmacy with wholesale medications at cost.
- C. Add full time Laboratory Technologist, and increase laboratory services.
- D. Increase Registered Dietician's hours from current 4 hours per week to 20 hours per
- E. Add on campus X-ray facilities with darkroom and at-cost services.
- F. Increase number of exam room from current 4 to 12 rooms, and add a surgical area.

Remember, students with private health insurance frequently do not use it, because of cash deductibles and no medication coverage!
