The UNLV Intramural Flag Football league "T-shirted" two respective champions over the October 28th weekend. After six weeks of competitive...and sometimes bruising...competition on the gridiron involving 36 teams, the men's and women's winners were **Hotel Association-Flamingo** and **Runnin' Devils**.

The men's single elimination bracket saw sixteen teams of the original 28 qualify for the post-season tournament. Early round winners included ΣΑΕ, Huckleberry's Possie, ΚΣ I and II, ΤΚΕ, ΣΦΕ 'A', ΑΤΩ and the eventual champions. In a rematch of an early season game, the Runnin' Devils avenged their loss to the New Girls on the Field, as the Devils demolished them in the championship 40-12.
