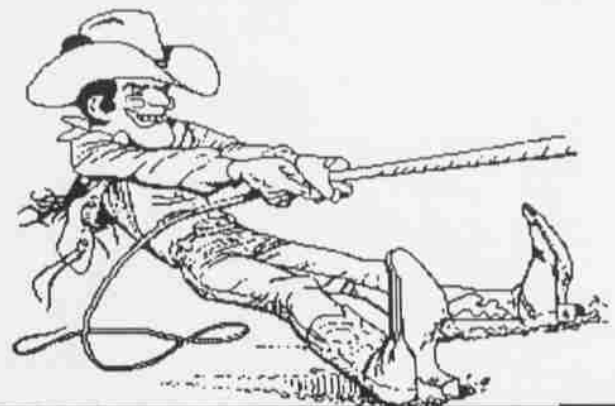
The men's competition will consist of bareback riding, saddle bronc riding, steer wrestling, bull riding, calf roping, and team roping. Women's

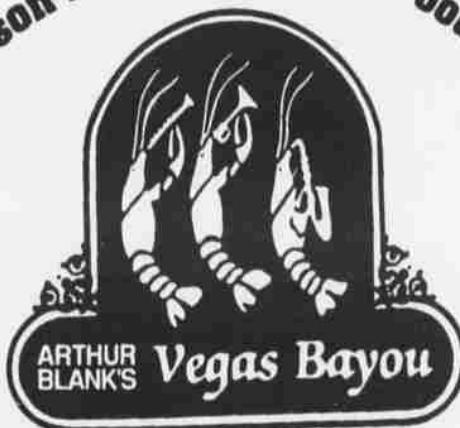

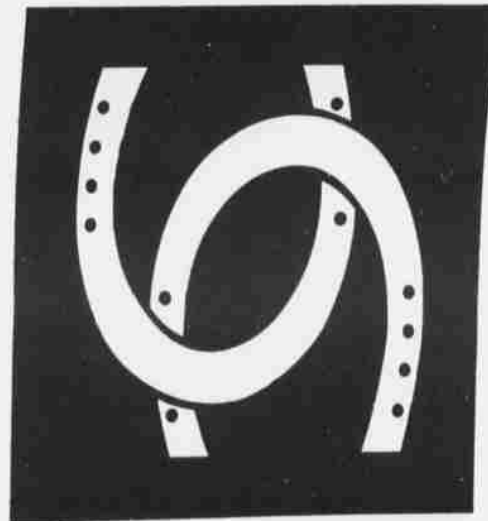
