

Boies bumped out of tournament

UNLV junior Patrice Boies gave notice he's ready for a big year by reaching the round of 16 at the Rolex Intercollegiate Tennis Tournament.

The pre-season event features the top players on the west coast and is a good indicator of which players will be ranked during the year.

Boies won his first match 7-5, 6-2 over Arizona States' Greg Prudhomme. He followed that up with a grueling three set win over UC Irvine's Neel Grover 4-6, 6-3, 6-4.

With the tournament being held in Irvine, Boies had to overcome Grover's inspired effort in front of the notoriously noisy Irvine fans.

Next for Boies was second-seeded Howard Joffe from Pepperdine. The two battled on even terms for the better part of the three sets. Boies captured the first set 6-7, but the seasoned Joffe fought back to escape with a narrow 6-3, 6-4 victory.

Boies indicated that while he had a respectable tournament, he thought he could have done better.

"I had a chance against Joffe and if I'd capitalized, I'm in the quarterfinals and I know what happens then," Boies said.

Another UNLV tennis player David Hostalek won three matches in the qualifying rounds before losing in the first round of the main draw.

Should all students, undergraduate and graduate, full and part time, pay a \$20⁰⁰ per semester fee for expansion of student health services?

Explanation:

The Student Health Center currently provides all UNLV students with a variety of limited health care services. However, a national survey comparing UNLV to similar colleges and universities found that UNLV's budget was significantly lower than other similar institutions. This negatively impacts the staffing and services of the UNLV Student Health Center by limiting the number of students seen and the types of services available to all students

Injure yourself on campus? Get sick in class? Have a problem you don't feel you can share with your family doctor? A "yes" vote would allow **all UNLV students** to continue to use the services at no cost for examination, and allow for expansion of staff and services.

I. Expansion of the Student Health Center will:

- A. Increase Physician's hours from current 20 hours per week to 40 hours per week, and add part time Physician specialists, ie, Allergist, Gynecologist, Dermatologist.
- B. Increase Pharmacist's hours from current 8 hours per week to 40 hours per week, and add a licensed pharmacy with wholesale medications at cost.
- C. Add full time Laboratory Technologist, and increase laboratory services.
- D. Increase Registered Dietician's hours from current 4 hours per week to 20 hours per week.
- E. Add on campus X-ray facilities with darkroom and at-cost services.
- F. Increase number of exam room from current 4 to 12 rooms, and add a surgical area.

Remember, students with private health insurance frequently do not use it, because of cash deductibles and no medication coverage!
