## Committee considers acute parking problems

More solutions to UNLV's parking dilemma are being considered by the parking committee chaired by Vincent H. Eade, assistant professor of the College of Hotel and Administration.

One idea is to remove the landscaping islands spread throughout the north end parking area which currently cover up about 110 spaces. Eade said that the committee is considering whether this immediate solution would affect the aesthetic quality of that area.

Another idea has been to begin a sched-

ule for the new shuttle system to pick up persons parking at the Thomas & Mack lot. Eade thinks that if people knew that a shuttle would arrive at specific times, they would feel more comfortable in choosing the Thomas and Mack lot for parking.

"We're aware of some acute parking problems on campus. We refer to these ideas as temporary or 'bandage' solutions that can only provide relief," Eade said.

He said that the committee is not an authority. It can only make suggestions to the President, who then decides whether or not the ideas are viable.
