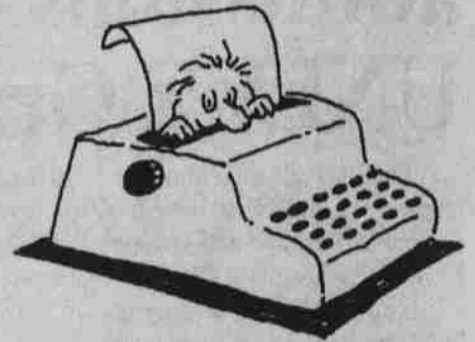
PRSSA news

She is the fourth speaker, in a series started by PRSAA last fall, to discuss various jobs opportunities in the public relations field.

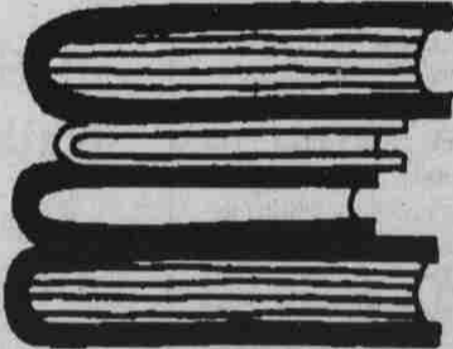
Newlon is responsible for overseeing the areas of media and public relations, community relations, employee communications, educational programs, publications and graphics.
