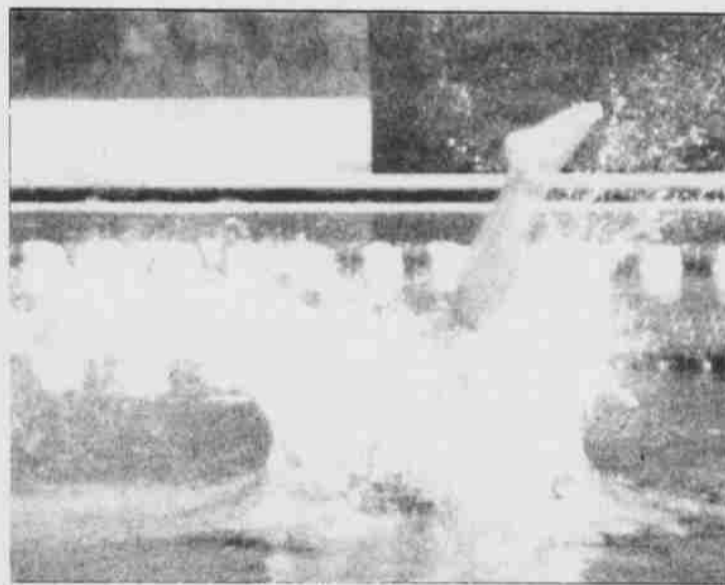

Runnin' Rebels keep perfect mark in Big West play

The Runnin' Rebels needed five extra minutes to post an 85-80 win over conference foe Utah State in Logan, Utah on Thursday.

The 21st-ranked Rebels who improved to 10-0 in the Big West Conference and 18-2 overall overcame the one-man attack put forth by Utah State's Kendall Youngblood, who scored a career-high 39 points. The final 10 points of the second half were scored by Youngblood.

But when the overtime

period started the Rebels took control going on a 12-7 run capped off by Reggie Manuel's three-pointer with less than two minutes remaining in the game. The Rebels as well as the Aggies hit key free throws in the extra minutes. All of the Aggies points in the overtime period came from the free-throw line.

The Rebels will travel to Santa Barbara, Calif., to face the UCSB Gauchos at 7:30 p.m. Thursday.

Lady Rebels drop two conference games

Long Beach State 91, UNLV 81

After winning their last seven games, the Lady Rebels have dropped two in a row in the Big West Conference, losing on the road to Long Beach State and UC Santa Barbara.

The Lady Rebels dropped a nationally-broadcasted contest Wednesday at Long Beach State 91-81 after running out of gas in the second half.

After trailing early, the Lady Rebels fought back to take a 36-34 lead at the half. Junior Arlene Miller scored 15 points in the first half to pace the Lady Rebels.

But in the second half, Miller scored only three points (all coming in the final minutes of the game) and the rest of the Lady Rebels slowed as the 49ers pulled away.

UNLV was led by Teresa Jackson with 25 points. Trise Jackson was high scorer for the 49ers with a career-high 30 points.

UC Santa Barbara 76, UNLV 61

At Santa Barbara, Calif., the Lady Rebels had their poorest output of the season as a tough Gaucho defense stifled them. Senior forward Sharon Hargrove was the only UNLV player to score in double figures with 12.

Teresa Jackson, the Lady Rebels leading scorer, was held to eight points on four-of-nine shooting from the field. UCSB was led by junior Becky Brown who scored 20 points.

The Lady Rebels will continue their road trip Thursday, travelling to play UC Irvine. Game time is 5 p.m.

KUNV schedules six Rebel baseball games

Once again KUNV, 91.5 FM will be the voice of the UNLV baseball team—well, sort of. Six Hustlin' Rebel baseball games can be heard live this year as a part of the station's expanded programming.

Jay Sapovits, the sports director at KUNV, will be the play-by-play announcer for the six games. Sapovits will joined in the booth by a guest announcer for each game. Former UNLV baseball player Jack Ayers will be the first to join

Sapovits.

"We thought this year six games with the programming as diverse as it already is would give us, as a station, a good base in the sports market when Rebel football, basketball and baseball all have broadcast availability for next year," Sapovits said.

A lot of people want to be sports announcers and few have come to the KUNV offices to become part of the station, Sapovits added.

Each broadcast will begin with a 15-minute pregame show, with player statistics, starting lineups and an interview with Head Coach Fred Dallimore

"For being under-budgeted year after year he does as good a job with that program as any coach in any sport in any state," said Sapovits about the little attention given to Rebel baseball.
