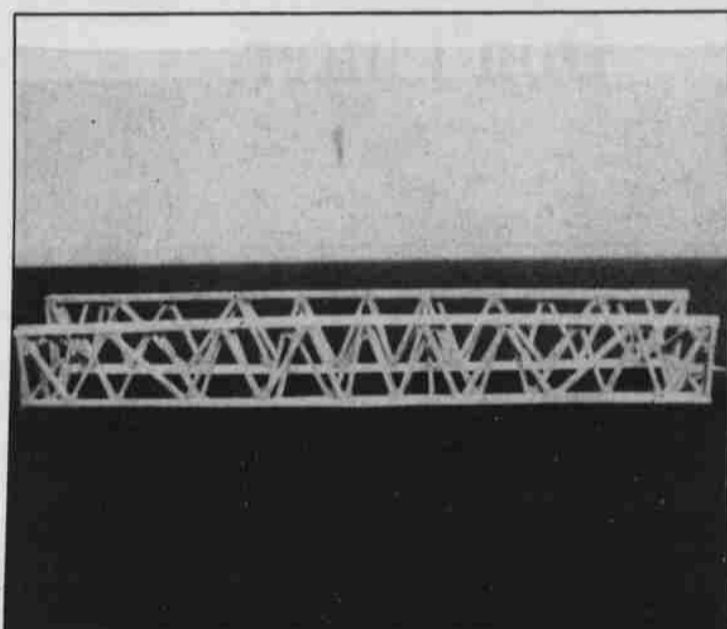
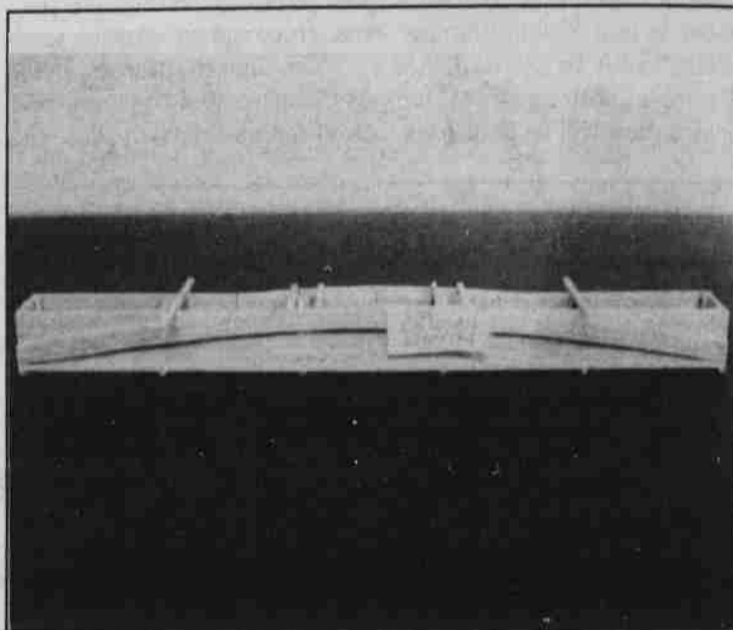
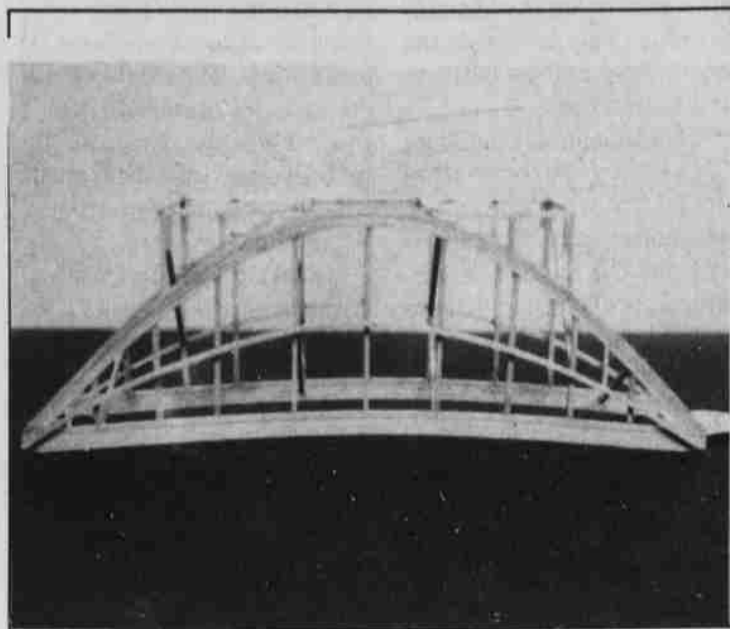


Southern Nevada students build bridges
