In Saturday's play in which both teams combined for 21 runs, the Rebels used last inning heroics to capture the 11-10 victory. The teams were tied 5-5 going into the ninth inning when the Rebels gave up five runs and fell behind 10-5. But the Rebels rebounded as they answered with six runs in the bottom of the ninth to escape with the win.

Tarkanian signs with NBA's Spurs

Well, it finally happened. Yet another member from UNLV's 1990 championship team and 1991's Final Four squad has graduated to the NBA.

This time it was former Rebel Head Coach Jerry Tarkanian.

Tarkanian ended much speculation Wednesday when he signed with the San Antonio Spurs.

The Spurs begin action in the NBA playoffs this week under interim coach Bob Bass. Tarkanian will assume the

reins next season.

Speculation now is that former UNLV assistant coach Tim Grgurich, currently an assistant with the Seattle Supersonics, will join Tarkanian in San Antonio.

Sonics coach George Karl recruited Grgurich when he was at the University of Pittsburgh, but the 12 years Grgurich spent with Tarkanian at UNLV may be the deciding factor.
