The African-American Students Awards Banquet will be held at 6 p.m. Sunday in the Tam Alumni Center. For ticket information call William Sullivan at 739-3871.

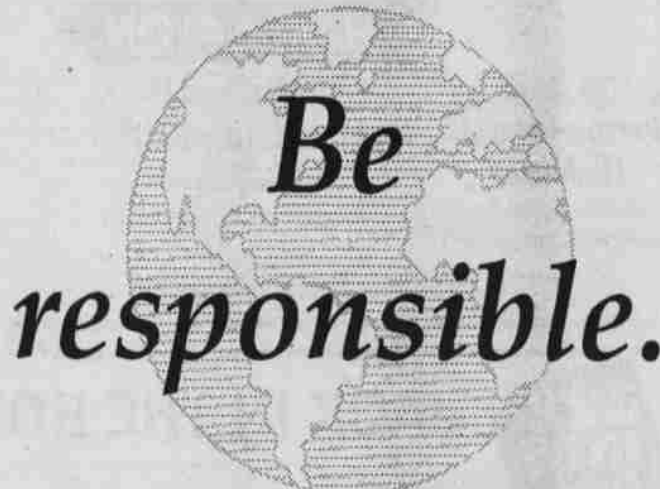
Photo Exhibit

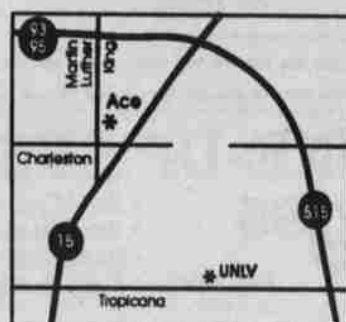
