How the rivalry started

Though not in the same historical category as such legendary collegiate football feuds as USC-UCLA, Stanford-Cal, or Miami vs. well, anyone, the UNLV-UNR battle for the Fremont Cannon stirs local passions just the same.

Heading into Saturday evening's Homecoming affair with the Wolf Pack, the Rebels hold an all-time series lead of 9-8 over UNR.

UNR, which now insists on

being simply labeled "Nevada," has won the last three interstate clashes, outscoring the Rebels by a combined 121-29. This includes last season's 50-8 drubbing of the Rebels.

UNLV last held possession of the lucrative Fremont Cannon following a 24-19 win in 1987. The schools did not face each other again until 1989 and have played annually ever since.

Though the two schools initially met in 1969, it wasn't until Thanksgiving a year later that the cannon was offered as spoils to the winner. In 1970, UNLV won that first Cannon Game, 42-30.

UNLV's first head coach, Bill Ireland, came up with the idea for a trophy as added incentive between the Rebels and Wolf Pack. In keeping with tradition, the cannon is fired every time its owner scores.

The cannon is a replica of the one trailblazer John C. Fremont used on his overland journey into western Nevada in 1843, hence the moniker attached to the howitzer.
