Tuition and fees History 1990-1992

Tuition refers to the charges assessed to out-of-state students. Fees refer to in-state charges.

May 1990

Board of Regents approve a Tuition and Fee Policy that uses the average rates of Western Interstate Commission on Higher Education (WICHE) institutions. Tuition increases 10 percent and fees 15 percent for 1990-91.

June 1990

Student leaders meet with Chancellor Mark Dawson and staff to amend the approved policy. A cap on increases limiting them to the WICHE average of the past five years plus one percent. In addition, it was agreed that the University of Nevada System would request full funding of the financial aid budget. Finally, a committee of system and campus administration is to meet annually to determine rates.

December 1990

Regents approve amendments

May 1991

Board of Regents approve increases of 9 percent for tuition and 6 percent for fees.

March 1992

Due to cuts in the state budget. UNLV President Robert Maxson and staff meet with the student advisory council to discuss increases for 1992-93. It was agreed that an extra increase up to \$5 per credit will be attached to the 1992-93 increases to offset budget cuts.

April 1992

Board of Regents approve 11 percent increase in tuition and 13 percent increases in fees. Chancellor forms special committee to review policy.

May-August 1992

Committee revises policy. Eliminates WICHE average as primary guide. Financial aid amendment is attached to policy requiring that a portion of future increases be earmarked for financial aid. Committee approves increases for 1993-94 and 1994-95. Overall tuition would increase 40 percent and fees 14 percent plus surcharges for a total of 22 percent. Regents delay vote on approval of the increases.

September 1992

Regents hold special meeting to revise Tuition and Fee policy. WICHE average is changed to median. Policy revisions results in UNLV freeze in 1993-94.

October 1992

Regents hold regularly scheduled meeting. Approve tuition increases of 6 percent for 1993-94 and 9 percent for 1994-1995. 5 percent increase in fees in 1994-95.
